

## NOTICE OF RACE

### **470 SOUTH AMERICAN CHAMPIONSHIP** **November 30th – December 3rd 2021** **Clube dos Jangadeiros, Porto Alegre – RS, Brasil**

#### **Organizing Authority:**

The South American Championship of Class 470 is organized by Clube dos Jangadeiros, in conjunction with the Brazilian Association of Class 470, under the supervision of the Brazilian Sailing Confederation (CBVela).

The notation '[DP]' in a rule/item of the Notice of Race means that the sanction for violation of this rule by decision of the protest committee may be less than a disqualification.

#### **1. RULES**

- 1.1. The Championship will be governed by the rules as defined in the WS Sailing Rules 2021-2024.
- 1.2. The requirements of the national authority will not apply.

#### **2. ADVERTISING**

- 2.1 ISAF Regulation 20 will be applied.
- 2.2 Participating boats may be required to carry advertising on the hull, determined and provided by the organization. If this rule is violated, World Sailing Regulation 20.9.2 will apply. [DP]

#### **3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

- 3.1 The Championship is open to all Class 470 boats and all boats must present a measurement certificate. All competitors must be members of the respective national class 470 association of their home country and meet their 2021 obligations with their respective state federations.
- 3.2 Sailors must be registered with "ISAF Sailor" and inform their ID when filling in the registration form.

#### **4. FEES**

- 4.1 Entry fee per boat:

### 6. CHAMPIONSHIP FORMAT

There will be no more than 3 races per day, but a 4th race may be sailed to bring the schedule up to date, but not to anticipate the schedule. On the last day scheduled for races, there will be no signal of attention for any race after 16:00h. RC will post on the Notice Board the number of races it intends to run on the day. Obeying the rules of the class, Appendix P5.1, items P5.2 and P5.3 will be applied.

### 7. MEASUREMENT AND INSPECTION

- 7.1 Each boat must have a valid measurement certificate.
- 7.2 Any boat can be inspected at any time during the event.

### 8. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

8.1 Sailing Instructions will be available after confirmation of entries at the Event Secretariat.

### 9. VENUE

9.1 The event will be headquartered at the Jangadeiros club, located at Rua Ernesto Paiva, 139-Tristeza neighborhood, Porto Alegre – RS, CEP 91900-240. The races will be held on the Guaíba River.

### 9.2 COURSES

Courses will be given in the sailing instructions including the angles between the legs, the order in which the marks must be passed, and the side on which each mark must be left.

The approximate duration of each regatta will be 50 minutes.

### 10. PENALTY SYSTEM

Appendix P - Special Procedures for Rule 42 will apply Appendix T-arbitrages

### 11. SCORING

11.1 The linear scoring system in Appendix A of the WS 2021/2024 rules will be used.

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11.2 Three 3 races must be completed to constitute the series.

11.3 When fewer than five (5) races have been completed, the boat's series score shall be the sum of her scores in each race.

11.4 When five (5) races to ten (10) races have been completed, the boat's series score will be the sum of her scores in each race, excluding her worst result.

### **12. PLACE OF STAY**

12.1 The boats must be kept in the places designated to them in the patios of the venue of the event. [DP]

### **13. COMMUNICATION BY RADIO AND ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT**

13.1 Except in an emergency, a boat may not make radio transmissions while racing or receive communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile phones and other means of communication. [DP], Gopro type cameras are released.

### **14. PRIZES**

14.1 Prizes will be awarded in accordance with Class rules as follows

1st to 5th places overall;

1st to 3rd places Junior (Sub 23);

1st and 2nd place Women.

### **15. RISK STATEMENT**

15.1 Competitors participate in the race at their own risk. Consider rule 4, Decision to Compete. The Organizing Authority will not accept any liability for material, physical or death damage directly related to the series of races and their antecedents, during or after the completion of the event.

15.2 The decision to participate in the championship characterizes a unilateral act by the competitor, aware of the risks that nautical activity poses.

### **16. SAFETY**

16.1 Whenever in the water the competitor must have personal flotation equipment on board. A rubber or waterproof suit is not personal flotation equipment. If personal flotation equipment

it is of a type of inflating, whenever it is in the water it must be fully inflated. This changes the RRV 40.
